She received her initial artistic training under her father, a professional sculptor, and her mother, an art enthusiast followed by the formal education receiving a Bachelor of Fine Arts. A child prodigy, she received her first best art award at the age of five and had her first solo show at the age of ten at the Gallery of the Union of Artists of Russia. Since then, she has exhibited her work not only in Russia but also in Japan, Canada, the UK, and the USA. Processing powerful pictorial imagination, excellent old school technique, and superb taste, Olga Nenazhivina creates graphic work, which aesthetics are a fine merger of the East and West.
